Words of wisdom delivered by Dr. Neelima Pathak, Dean, of Humanities and Linguistics, Yoga & Naturopathy, SBU Ranchi. She highlighted the fact that how Britishers ruined the Indian traditional education system and destroyed the Sanskrit language. In Indian knowledge Sanskrit is considered pure and called "Sur Bharati" She mentioned NASA's use of Sanskrit as an apt language, Sanskrit's grammatical structure makes it a good contender for programming languages or artificial intelligence because it is less ambiguous than modern languages. She also mentioned the great Indian scientists C. V. Raman, Jagadish Chandra Bose, Homi J. Bhabha, Jagadish Chandra Bose, A. P. J. Abdul Kalam, Meghnad Saha, and G. N. Ramachandran etc. to name a few who contributed in Indian Knowledge system.

any nation does not require the use of atomic bombs or the use of long-range missiles. The collapse of education is the collapse of the nation. He emphasises rich heritage of Indian culture, he highlights how the Mughals and Britishers ruined our original knowledge system. He further talks about IKS incorporating in the curriculum. Tribal natural farming, medicine, and culture should be properly documented. Ethical, spiritual, moral, and holistic development is important. He talks about the Nalanda and Takshashila which were educational hubs of the traditional education system. UGC said that 5% of the curriculum should be the Indian knowledge system. In the modern education system, there is a need for environmental and forest management, ethical and moral development, a specialized teacher training system, multi-entry, multi-exit system, internship, and practical study more than theory class, focusing on students leadership quality.
