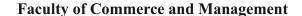


Sarala Birla University

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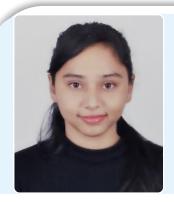
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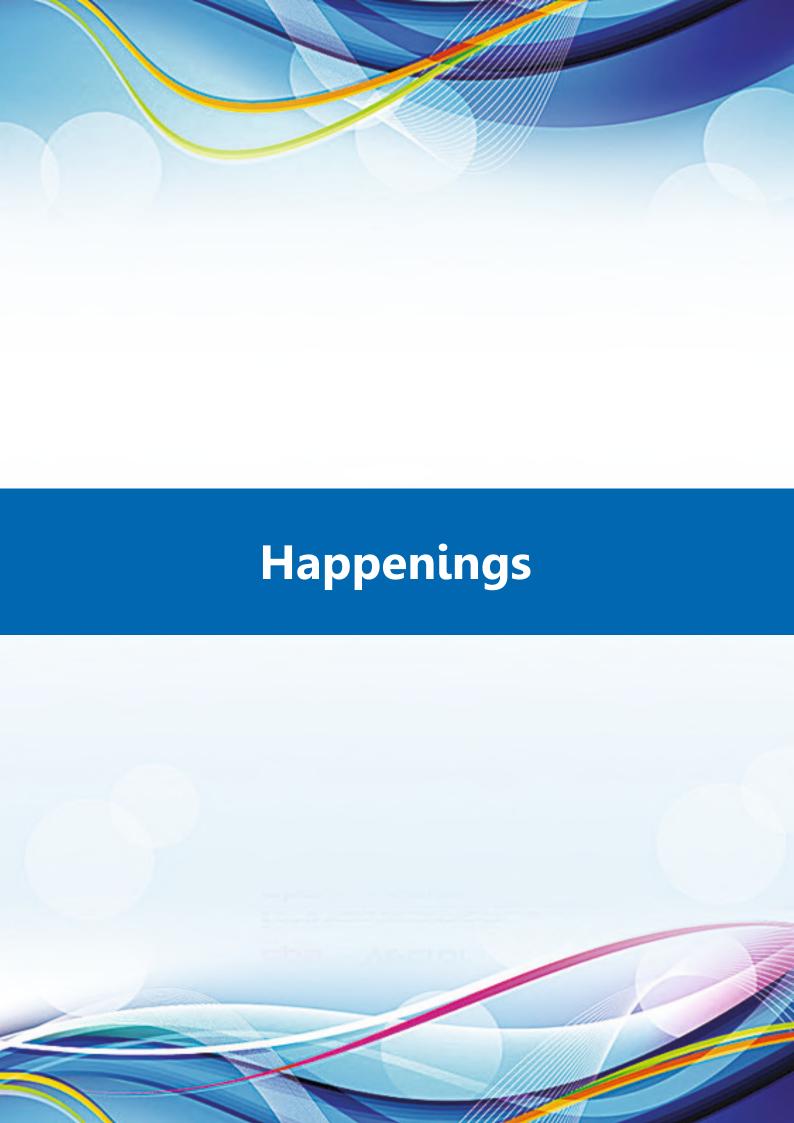

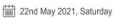

Invited Lecture from Harvard Business School

on

"Making the Hardest Leadership Decisions"

A webinar was organized by the Faculty of Commerce and Management of Sarla Birla University under the chairmanship of Professor Gopal Pathak, Honorable Vice Chancellor of the University on the topic "Making the Hardest Leadership Decisions". The keynote speaker of the webinar was **Prof. Joseph L. Badaracco, John Shad Professor of Business Ethics, Harvard Business School, USA.** Prof. Badaracco elaborated on the various aspects of Hardest Leadership Decisions. He mentioned that every leader has to take many important decisions in his life and career, which sometimes involves taking very difficult decisions. He also stated that a successful leader should not take any difficult decision in a biased manner. He discussed the decisions of Apple creator Steve Jobs and explained why he had to leave the Microsoft Company. He advised on taking fair decisions by avoiding the emotional side to become a successful leader. He also elaborated about difficult, complex and necessary decisions to be taken judiciously to deal with various conflicts. 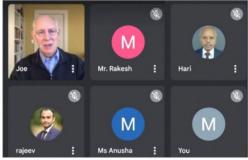

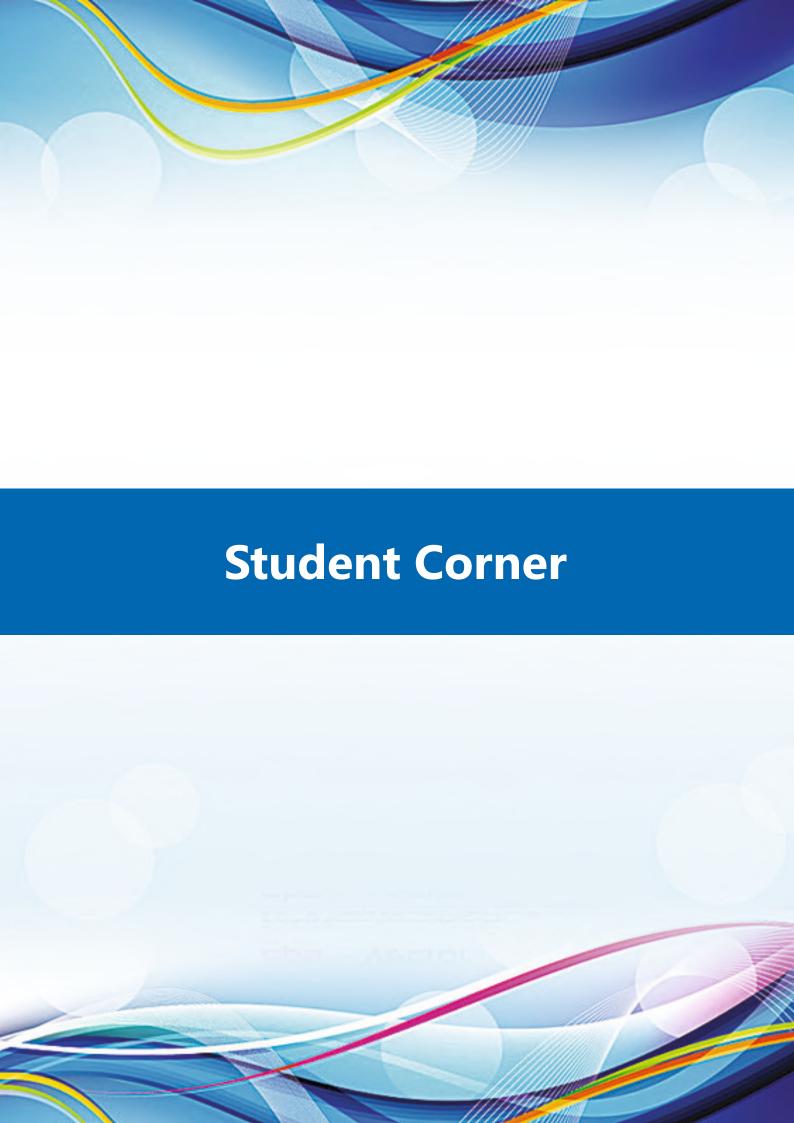

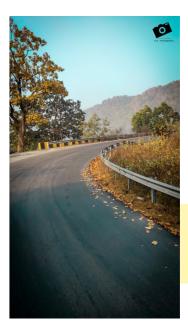
