SBU observed Tribal Pride Day on the occasion of 146th Birth Anniversary of Bhagwan Birsa Munda. On this occasion, Dr Gopal Pathak, VC, Sarala Biral University told that the life, struggle and supreme sacrifice of the tribal hero Birsa Munda will always be remembered. He launched *ulgulan* (Great Tumult) at a young age which unnerved the British power. He led agitations against unjust taxation policy of the British government which landed him in Hazaribagh jail in 1894 where he remained for two years. When he was released from the jail, he launched armed struggle against the British Raj which continued till his arrest in 1900. He finally died of tortures inflicted on him behind the bars. He was a great voice and a leader against exploitation and slavery.
