The Expert Talk 2025, titled "Exploring Career Pathways in the Evolving Securities and Financial Market", was organized on 18th February 2025 with the aim of providing students with in-depth insights into career opportunities in the financial markets. The event featured a distinguished keynote address by Mr. Subhayu Das, Assistant General Manager at the National Institution of Securities Market (SEBI), Mumbai. Mr. Das shared valuable knowledge on various career options, the evolving nature of the securities market, and ways for students to enter and excel in the field.

The event began by a brief introduction of the keynote speaker, Mr. Subhayu Das. Subhayu Das was having 16 years of experience in the field of Training and Development of Finance industry. He is certified in Executive Learning from IIM Rohtak and IIT Delhi in Project management. He is also a certified Lean Six Sigma Black Belt holder and Generative AI project Manager from PMI. He started his career after MBA with Toyota and after that having experience in NIIT and in BSE Institute for 10 years and presently designated as an AGM with NISM (A capacity building initiative of SEBI)



As the inaugural procession took place, Dr. Mukesh Babu Gupta, HoD In-Charge, Faculty of Commerce, Sarala Birla University gave the Welcome Address.

Dr. Sandeep Kumar, Dean, Faculty of Commerce and Director of IQAC, Sarala Birla University gave his words of wisdom and motivated the students to participate actively in the expert talk. He welcomed the guests and expert Mr. Subhayu Das and said that the session will be an invaluable opportunity for commerce students to gain insights into the dynamic and ever-expanding world of finance, investments, and securities markets.

He emphasized that the financial sector is undergoing rapid transformation due to technological advancements, regulatory changes, and global economic shifts. He stated that in the present world, financial markets are no longer confined to traditional stock exchanges but have expanded into areas such as digital assets, algorithmic trading, decentralized finance (DeFi), and sustainable investing. This evolution presents new challenges and exciting career opportunities for aspiring professionals.

He motivated the students and said that careers in financial markets are no longer limited to conventional roles like investment banking and stockbroking. Emerging opportunities now exist in areas such as financial analytics, risk management, fintech innovation, wealth management, and regulatory compliance. The integration of artificial intelligence, blockchain technology, and data analytics has revolutionized the way financial markets operate, creating new career paths that require a blend of financial acumen and technological expertise.

He guided the students that the expert talk is designed to provide them with first-hand industry knowledge from professionals who have navigated the complexities of financial markets. He also encouraged them to engage actively, ask insightful questions, and learn about the skills required to thrive in this sector. To excel in this evolving landscape, he emphasized them to focus on continuous learning, adaptability, and developing a strong ethical foundation.

The primary objective of the event was to familiarize students with career opportunities in the securities and financial market, guiding them on the necessary skills and qualifications required to establish a successful career in this domain. The event also aimed to bridge the gap between academic learning and industry requirements by providing practical knowledge from an expert in the field.

After the brief Introduction, Mr. Subhayu Das delivered an insightful and engaging session covering various aspects of financial markets and careers related to them. Some of the key highlights from his talk included:



1. Overview of the Securities and Financial Market and NISM

Mr. Das provided a comprehensive overview of the securities and financial market, explaining the roles of different institutions such as SEBI, stock exchanges, depositories, mutual funds, and investment banks. He emphasized how globalization and technological advancements have significantly transformed the financial sector, leading to new opportunities and challenges.

2. Career Opportunities in the Financial Market

Mr. Das outlined several career options available to students in the securities and financial market, including roles in mergers and acquisitions, equity research, and portfolio management, Opportunities in equity research, algorithmic trading, and technical analysis, careers in SEBI, RBI, and other regulatory institutions overseeing market integrity, Helping individuals and institutions in financial planning and wealth growth, Understanding risk assessment in banking and non-banking financial sectors, and Emerging roles in quantitative analysis, AI-based trading, and financial technology innovations.

3. Skills and Qualifications Required

Mr. Das emphasized the importance of specific skills and qualifications needed to succeed in the securities and financial market, such as Degrees in economics, finance, commerce, or business administration, along with professional certifications such as CFA, FRM, and NISM certifications. ALSO, Proficiency in financial modeling, quantitative analysis, and programming languages like Python and R for data-driven decision-making was required, which could be done from various institutions which he briefed about. And along with it, strong analytical thinking, problem-solving abilities, and communication skills essential for working in financial markets.





Ways to Enter and Excel in the Field
