

A workshop on the topic of "Perspective on Research and Innovation" was organized by Sarala Birla University on 22.2.25 (Saturday) in G.D. Birla Auditorium. The Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor of the university, Prof. C. Jeganathan took the initiative to organize this workshop. The workshop was based on research and innovation, wherein he briefed the audience about the need of research in personal and professional life. He provided insights into best practices, emerging trends, and funding opportunities. The workshop also offers guidance on securing research grants and collaborating with industry partners. He provided valuable insights into preparing effective research proposals and highlighted the role of national and international collaborations. He explained science, research, innovation, engineering and entrepreneurship by giving many inspiring audio visual examples. While elaborating the Bloom's Taxonomy in academics, he discussed ways to implement it in UG, PG and Ph.D. levels. He also discussed about the hot and important areas of research and innovation around the world.

In the workshop, Hon'ble Director General Prof. Gopal Pathak shared the insights about the international collaborations of Sarala Birla University with institutions of repute round the world especially USA. In his address, he stated that the identity of any University is defined by its research and innovation. He highlighted the international collaborations of Sarala Birla University with University of California, Berkeley, University of California, San Diego, University of Minnesota and University of Vermont for various opportunities like international student's exchange, faculty exchange and collaborative research.
